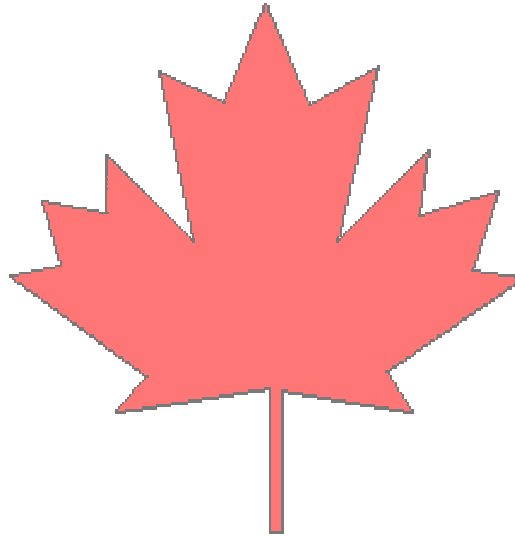

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# Alberta



- 1670 area was Rupert's Land under Hudson's Bay Company, later part of North-West Territories
- 1731 French settlements
- 1870 BMD Registration, but a few BMD date back to 1850
- 1882 part of North-West Territories was declared "District of Alberta"
- 1905 Alberta enlarged & declared a province
- "Vital Statistics" searches & certificates must be ordered through an agent



# British Columbia



- 1774 Explored by Spaniard Hernández
- 1790 Spanish settlement formed
- 1795 British seized control
- 1871 became province
- BC Archives has free online indexes to:  
births 1872-1903, baptisms 1836-1885,  
marriages 1859-1932, deaths 1872-1987
- Genweb has some electoral rolls, censuses,  
directories, indexes to newspaper extracts

# Manitoba



- 1611 Henry Hudson sailed into "Hudson Bay"
- 1668 first trading voyage led to founding of Hudson's Bay Company & NW Company - both set up fur trading forts (then in NW Territories)
- Many French traders as well, led to French and Indian war of 1763, won by Britain
- 1870 became a province
- Hudson's Bay Company Archives now in Winnipeg
- Genweb has land grants, cemetery indexes, censuses

# New Brunswick



- 1534 explored by Jacques Cartier (French)
- 1604 Colony founded
- French controlled until 7 years War (1756-63) after which controlled by Britain
- 1783 American Revolutionary War ended, with Maine/ New Brunswick border unresolved
- 1838-9 a bloodless war
- 1867 New Brunswick was one of 4 original provinces of Canada, joining Confederation
- Only constitutionally bilingual province (French & English)

# Newfoundland & Labrador



- Newfoundland is an island – Labrador is on mainland
- **AD 1000** L'Anse aux Meadows (on Newfoundland) founded by Leif Ericson's Vikings (first known settlement by Europeans in Americas)
- **1497** John Cabot "rediscovered" for England
- **1583** Sir Humphrey Gilbert claimed Newfoundland as England's first overseas colony
- **1907** became (independent) dominion
- **1949** joined Canada as "Newfoundland province"
- **1964** renamed "Newfoundland & Labrador"

### In re

Richard Webber deceased.

This is the last will and testament of me **Richard Webber** Seaman and at present Mate of the *Annie Laurie* in St. John's Newfoundland, I appoint the **Revd. Mr. Harris**, Wesleyan Minister, and at present in St. John's my executor. I bequeath to my said executor his executors, administrators and assigns my house and land at Monkstown and all other my property of which I may die possessed or entitled unto, in trust to lease and properly manage and care for the said house land and property and pay over the annual proceeds and profits thereof to my wife **Elizabeth** for her use and support so long as she shall live and continue unmarried, and on her death or marriage to pay the said annual proceeds and profits to and for the use and support of my child or children share and share alike if more than one and if but one for the use and support of that one And on the death of all my said children I direct that the said house, land and property shall be divided equally between my brothers and sisters who shall then be living if more than one and if but one all to that one.

In witness whereof I have signed and published this as my last will this 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1857 at St. John's, Newfoundland.

# Nova Scotia



- 1497 John Cabot landed
- 1604 French colony Acadia established
- 1620 "Plymouth Council for New England" declared Chesapeake Bay to Acadia as "New England"
- 1621 first Scottish settlement under 1<sup>st</sup> Earl of Stirling, initially failed for lack of emigrants
- 1624 James VI declared new order of baronets, for those who sent 6 labourers or artisans, armed & supplied for 2 years - for 6 months nobody took up offer until James compelled





# Nova Scotia (cont)



- 1629 declared to be part of mainland Scotland
- 1631 Charles 1 ceded Acadia to France
- Conquered or ceded alternately by Britain & France until "Great Expulsion" of Acadians in 1755
- 1867 became province
- 1868 voted to secede & refused to recognize Confederation - never rescinded



# Nova Scotia (cont)



- Late **1770s** in Nova Scotia town clerks began recording BMDs (incomplete)
- Civil Registration **1864-1877** then lapsed
- **1908** Civil registration restarted – residents could do “delayed registration” for identification
- Genweb has censuses from **1817**, Passenger Lists

# Ontario



- **1610-11** Henry Hudson searched unsuccessfully for a polar route to Asia. After camping through winter, he planned to continue the search but his crew mutinied & set him adrift in open sea. Survivors of mutiny were acquitted of murder, in exchange for their knowledge of the New World
- **1770s** settled by Loyalists escaping American Revolution
- War of **1812** between America & Britain (& thus Canada)
- Immigrants 20% English, 20% Scottish, 60% Irish
- **1867** one of original 4 provinces in Confederation

# Prince Edward Island



- Originally part of French colony of Acadia
- **1755** many came from Nova Scotia expulsion
- **1763** France gave to Britain after 7 Years War & it was renamed "St John's Island"
- **1775** 1<sup>st</sup> invasion by Americans of foreign land
- Attracted Loyalist refugees from America
- **1798** renamed "Prince Edward Island"
- Fashionable retreat for 19<sup>th</sup> century British nobility
- Rejected joining Confederation in **1867** but fears of American expansion led to joining in **1873**





# Prince Edward Island



- 1906 Civil Registration began
- Many church records lost to fire / flood, but (some of) the following survive:
  - Baptisms 1886-1906
  - Marriages 1787-1919
  - Burials prior to 1906
  - BMD after 1906

Held at Public Archives Office of PEI & must be searched on site or by agent

- PEI Genweb has Censuses from 1728, Directories, Passenger Lists, Baptisms 1777-1886, Wills



# Quebec (Québec)



- 1534 Jacques Cartier claimed for France
- 1541 First French colony in "New France"
- 1608 Quebec City founded
- 1620s RC priests began keeping BMDs
- RC church controlled 30% of New France (Acadia, Quebec, Newfoundland & Louisiana)
- Church chartered "Compagnie des Cent-Associés"
  - fur trade control in exchange for expanding & settling New France



# Quebec (Québec)



- 1662 Church-sponsored company dissolved
- 1663-1759 New France a province of France
- Britain won 7 Years War, ruled Quebec 1760-1867
- 1867 Quebec became a province of Canada
- 1926 Civil Registration in Quebec province separated from church record keeping

# Saskatchewan



- **1774** Hudson's Bay Co post first settlement
- **1870s** Northwest Territories founded between British Columbia & Manitoba
- **1874** North West Mounted Police settled (largely to keep out US expansion). They then allowed BC to link by rail to eastern Canada, rather than US
- **1880s** Canadian Pacific Railway built - free land to any willing settlers
- **1885** North-West Rebellion by "First Nation" Métis, declared provisional govt - leader hanged
- **1905** became province

# Nunavut

- BMD by mail - was & is necessary to travel outside territory for medical treatment so births & deaths often elsewhere



# Yukon Territory



- 19<sup>th</sup> century Hudson Bay Company fur traders
- 1846 John Bell established trading post at what would become Fort Yukon - then in Russian Alaska
- 1867 Russia feared unable to defend Alaska from British - sold Alaska to US (\$7.2 million)
- 1869 Alaska expelled Hudson's Bay Company
- 1885 discovery of gold, led to NWMP in area
- 1897 Klondike Gold Rush, led to railway
- 1898 created as separate territory (fears of large number of American miners)
